Objectives and investment policy

The investment objective of this sub-fund is to preserve the investor's capital and to provide an adequate return on the investment.

In order to achieve its objective, the sub-fund invests in units of other UCITS/UCIs that in turn invest both in equities (company shares) and fixed income (bonds), including Exchange Traded Funds (ETFs), and index funds. The purpose is to obtain cost-effective, well diversified and worldwide exposure, in order to secure a good long-term return at a limited risk.

The sub-fund aims to invest predominantly in fund units but may also invest in transferable securities, money-market instruments and accounts with credit institutions.

The sub-fund may use financial derivative instruments, except for total return swaps and other financial derivative instruments with similar characteristics, to achieve its objective and/or to reduce risks.

The sub-fund has the objective of not falling below 90 per cent of the highest price achieved over a one-year period. Although every effort is made to achieve the investment objectives of the sub-fund, no formal guarantee can be given as to whether the investment objectives will be achieved.

The sub-fund conducts responsible investments based on three principal pillars: active engagement, positive selection and exclusion. The sub-fund aims to invest in funds that promotes environmental or social characteristics or in funds that demonstrate improving sustainable characteristics. These funds are selected through the use of proprietary research and ratings. The sub-fund is actively managed without reference to a benchmark.

The currency of the share class is SEK.

Under normal circumstances, you may sell your shares on each complete bank business day in Luxembourg and in Sweden, except 24 December and 31 December.

These shares are capitalisation shares. Income and capital gains are reinvested.

Recommendation

This sub-fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

Risk and reward profile



What does this synthetic risk and reward indicator mean?

- The shares of class A are classified in category 3 because the value of the share may be subject to medium variations and consequently the risk of loss and the opportunity of gain may be moderate.
- The risk category has been determined using the maximum risk limit allowed for this share class. The risk category may not be a reliable indicator of the share class's future risk profile. The risk category shown is not guaranteed and may change over time.
- The seven-category scale is complex, for example 2 is not twice as risky as 1. The gap between 1 and 2 might not be the same as the gap between 5 and 6. A category 1 sub-fund is not a risk-free

investment - the risk of losing your money is small, but the chance of making gains is also limited.

Which materially relevant risks are not adequately captured by the synthetic risk and reward indicator?

- Liquidity risk: low liquidity might result in that it would be difficult or impossible to buy or sell an investment instrument in a timely manner and that the price could be lower or higher than expected.
- Operational risk: the risk of loss resulting from e.g. system breakdowns, human errors or from external events.
- Counterparty risk: the risk that a counterparty does not fulfill its obligations to the sub-fund (e.g. not paying an agreed amount or not delivering securities as agreed).

Charges

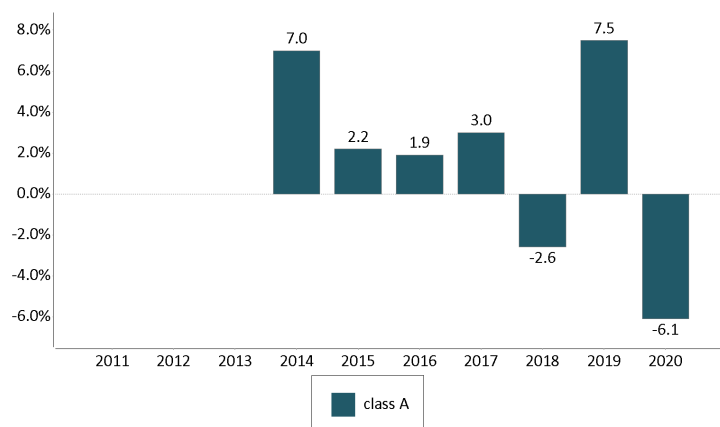
The ongoing charges relate to the annual charges; they were calculated on 31.12.2020. The ongoing charges may vary from year to year.
